All Concerned Agree To:

- \oplus Live up to a high standard of good sportsmanship at all times.
- \oplus Honor the decisions made by each Team as to the makeup of their team(s).

Decisions are made in the best interest of all involved.

- \oplus Treat opponents with respect; always be considerate.
- \oplus Respect the judgment of the contest officials even if you disagree.
- \oplus Trust the judgment of the coaches even if you disagree.
- \oplus Let the coaches coach the games.
- \oplus Avoid profane/aggressive language and obnoxious behavior.
- \oplus Always set a good example for our youth to follow; be a good role model.
- \oplus Accept both victory and defeat with pride and compassion.
